

WETD-FM Issues & Program List - January 10, 2018

As required quarterly by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), this Issues and Program List will identify the programs aired over WETD 90.7 FM, State University of New York, Alfred, NY 14802 over the preceding quarter. In order to fulfill part 73.3527 of Title 47 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) regarding non-commercial, educational radio stations, WETD 90.7 FM is required by the Federal Communication Commission (FCC) to submit a Quarterly List reflecting the "licensee's most significant programming treatment of community issues". The Issues – Program List must be filed in the Public Inspection File each quarter (On January 10, April 10, July 10, and October 10).

WETD 90.7 FM is owned by The State University of New York (SUNY). Alfred State College's (ASC) President, Dr. Irby (Skip) Sullivan, and the ASC President's Counsel currently oversee the daily operations of the radio station. WETD is funded and operated as an ASC Student Senate-funded club.

WETD continues to determine conclusively what current issues are affecting our community, and provide serious treatment for our listeners within the FCC defined guidelines for Issues and Programming Lists. The WETD Board of Directors (BOD) utilizes community-wide surveys to stay in tune with our audience. WETD leadership looks at each identified area from these continuing surveys to provide need-specific and timely programming for our listeners.

For this quarter, the Issues & Programming list includes **51%, Legislative Gazette, and The Steve Pomeranz Show.**

51% includes illuminating features and interviews focusing on issues of particular concern to women. Host Susan Barnett talks to experts in their field for a wide-ranging, entertaining discussion of traditional 'women's issues' and other global topics. The program is produced by WAMC/Northeast Public Radio's National Productions, 318 Central Avenue, Albany NY 12206 in cooperation with Russell Sage College, Troy, NY.

Legislative Gazette is an in-depth look at New York State politics and government. Hosted by David Guistina, the program features regular commentary by syndicated columnist and political scientist Dr. Alan Chartock. On each program, the award-winning WAMC News Team (Albany) combines forces to bring you a wrap-up of the political news, the goings on in and around the NYS legislature, and the stories that will keep you well informed and in the know. 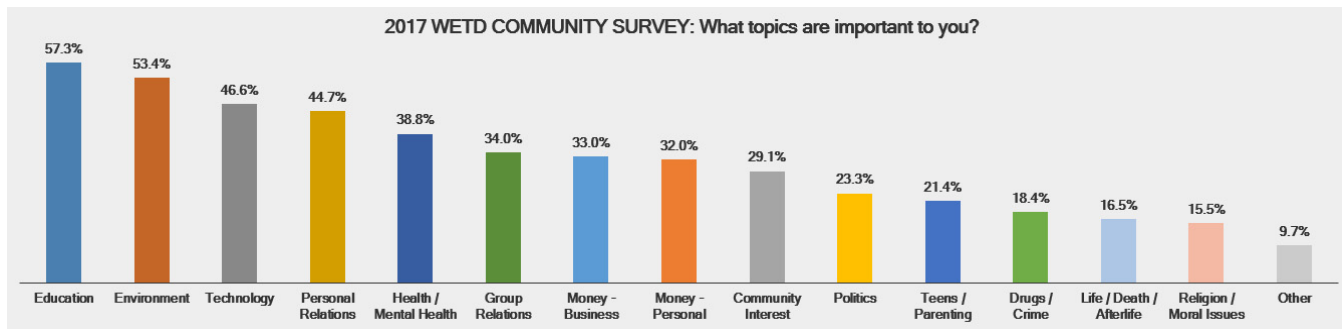

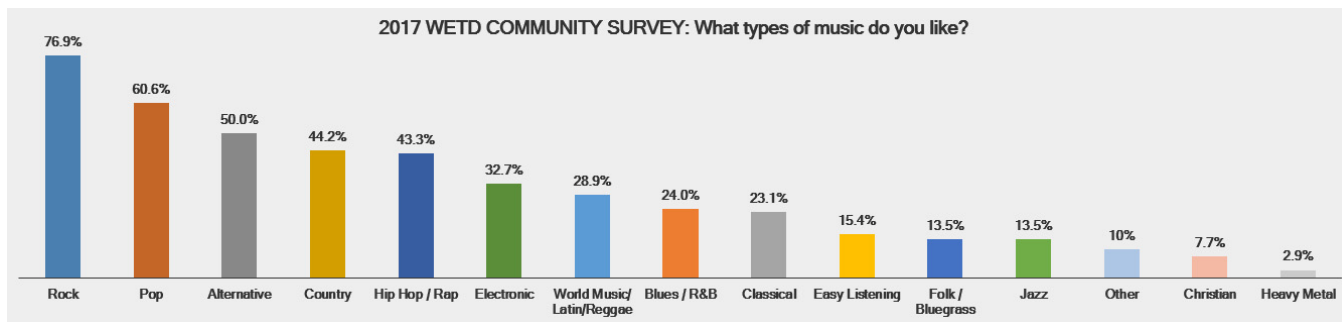
2017 WETD Community Survey

In order to identify the most significant issues facing our community, WETD conducts community surveys with multiple choice answers and fill-in-the-blank opportunities for responding ‘other.’ Based on these results, WETD is committed to providing the best programming to address important topics.

The following is the Significant Topics Chart based on responses to the WETD Community Survey completed at the Hot Dog Day Festival in April. Each year the Hot Dog Day Festival attracts a large audience of local residents and people from the region surrounding Alfred, NY. Survey respondents represent communities across Western New York, the Southern Tier, and the immediate local area.



The WETD Community Survey also asks respondents what types of music they like. WETD programs a variety of musical genres and survey results help to guide decisions regarding programming choices and the acquisition of new music.



The most popular survey responses for music genres are **rock, pop, alternative, country, hip hop/rap, electronic, world music, and blues.**

The WETD Community Survey represents a wide variety of perspectives:

- 58% College Student**
- 42% Not a College Student**
- 53% WETD Listener**
- 47% Not a WETD Listener**

Listening to the radio was the most frequent answer for ways in which survey respondents enjoyed music during the past month:

- 79% AM/FM Radio**
- 57% Purchased Music**
- 54% Pandora**
- 44% Spotify**
- 41% Online Streaming of Radio**
- 5% YouTube Music**
- 4% Sirius XM**
- 3% Amazon Music**
- 3% Apple Music**
- 3% SoundCloud**

In a show of support for the radio station's value, **79% say they are more likely to spend money with a business that is supportive of WETD.**
